1. Summary regarding the political subdivision's spending decision regarding the funds:

CVHD and the City of Jamestown agreed to use funds to provide and support education to the youth to discourage opioid and other substance misuse.

- The purchase and implementation of an evidence-based prevention curriculum, Keeping it Reel, designed to prevent substance use and enhance social and emotional competencies among youth was implemented within the Jamestown Middle School.
- Poster contest was hosted for vaping, tobacco, and other drug prevention to all fifth-grade classrooms throughout Jamestown Public Schools. Students received information regarding the dangers of use and then created a poster presenting the knowledge. A billboard and bench with the winning poster was displayed for the community of Jamestown.
- Collaborated with the JPS to bring the Steered Straight presentation to all students in grades 9-12 and also a separate presentation offered to the entire community. The program aims to empower students to make positive choices to avoid substance misuse, with focus on marijuana and vaping. Over 1,000 people attended these events.
