
Agency Name: Central Valley Health District and Stutsman County.

1. Summary regarding the political subdivision's spending decision regarding the funds:

CVHD and the Stutsman County Commission agreed to use funds to provide and support education to the youth to discourage opioid and other substance misuse.

- The purchase and implementation of an evidence-based prevention curriculum, Keeping it Reel, designed to prevent substance use and enhance social and emotional competencies among youth was implemented within one of the county schools. They are currently on the second year of this curriculum. The program was offered to the other rural county schools.
- Collaborated with the counselor in the rural schools of Stutsman County to bring the Steered Straight presentation to all students in grades 9-12 and also a separate presentation offered to the entire community. The program aims to empower students to make positive choices to avoid substance misuse, with focus on marijuana and vaping. Over 1,000 people attended these events.
