2025 Walsh County Opioid Settlement Funds Report

In 2025, opioid settlement funds received by Walsh County and Walsh County Health District were used to bolster activities already in place in Walsh County. These activities included:

1. Increasing the availability of Naloxone in Walsh County, including Walsh County Corrections, local schools, local pharmacies, law enforcement and first responders, and citizens.
2. Providing Naloxone education to various groups in Walsh County.
3. Supporting Medication Assisted Treatment at Community Health Services Inc.
4. Providing advertising and messaging about opioids and prevention.
5. Promotion of any medication take back events.

Additionally, funding of \$69,250.00 was used to sustain efforts within Walsh County Corrections in providing mental health services for incarcerated individuals with substance use disorders. Walsh County subcontracts with Agassiz Associates, PLLC in Grand Forks to provide these services.

Settlement dollars of \$5710.00 were used to provide access to CredibleMind, a digital platform for improvement of mental health by prevention, early intervention, and evidence-based self-care. The program provides access to a comprehensive collection of apps, videos, podcasts, articles, books, and other resources, including referral for diagnosis and treatment for over 200+ topics.
