How Crossroads Can Help You:

Transportation

- Get help covering transportation costs

Child Care Costs

- Waived co-payment under the Child Care Assistance Program (CCAP)

Case Management

Get personalized support in:

- Parenting skills
- Child care selection
- Housing
- Decision making
- Goal setting

Educational Incentive

- Incentive payment for achieving goals

Graduation Incentive

- Incentive payment upon completion of high school, GED and college

See if You Qualify:

Crossroads can help if you are:

- Currently pregnant or a parent
- Pursuing an education
- Under the age of 21
 - Exception: If you are already participating in Crossroads and are enrolled in a bachelor's degree program, you are eligible until you complete your degree.
- Married or unmarried
- The primary caregiver of your child
- Living in North Dakota
- Living in the same house with your child
