Serious Effects

Opiate-like effects at high doses and highly addictive;
DEA has listed kratom as Drug and Chemical of Concern.

Unregulated & Unrestricted

No kratom products are FDA approved.

Kratom products (gummies, drinks) are widely sold in North Dakota convenience stores and smoke shops with no age requirements.
