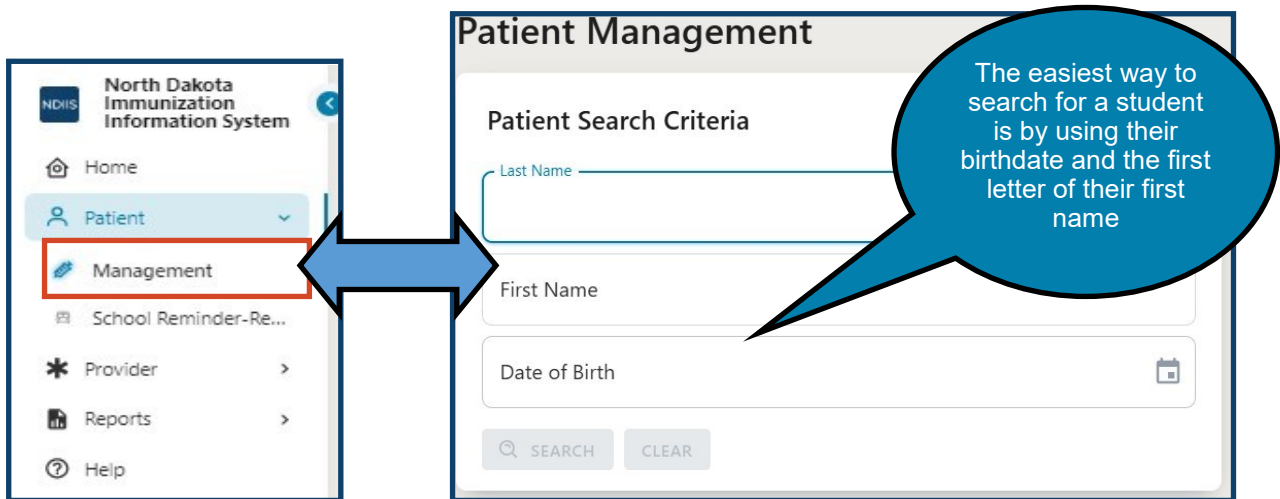


School Immunization Forecaster

Getting Started

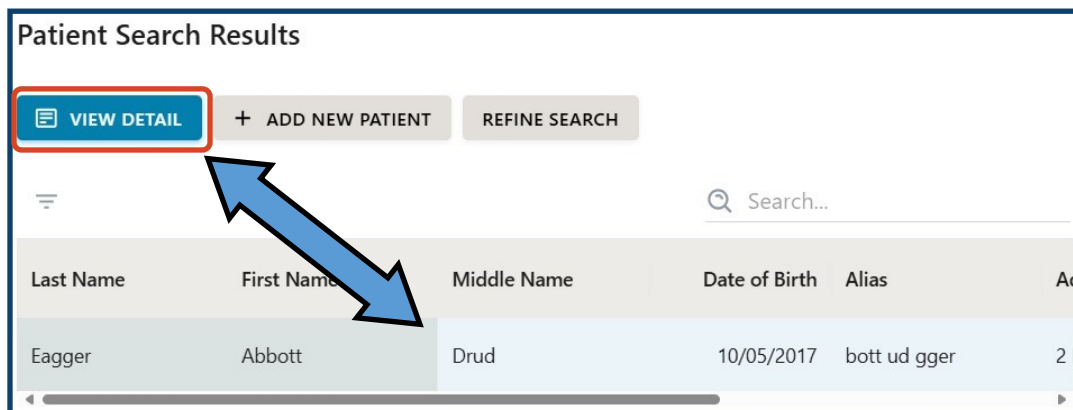
1.) Find the individual student record by clicking on the **Patient** option of the NDIIS **Main Menu** and then clicking **Management** from the drop-down. This will open the **Patient Search Criteria**.



2.) Search for your student using a combination of first name, last name, and date of birth. Click **Search** to generate the list of potential matches.

The NDIIS will return up to 100 possible matches based on the search criteria entered.

3.) To open the student record, click on the name from the search results to highlight it then click **View Detail**.



- 4.) The record will open to the student's **Core Demographics**. Demographic information should be reviewed and updated every time a record is accessed.
- 5.) The **Immunizations Forecast** can be viewed and printed by clicking on the **Generate Forecast** button in the **Patient Details** header.

Immunization Forecast

The immunization forecast will open as a PDF with all school required immunizations highlighted. The forecaster includes:

- ⇒ **Student name, birthdate, and age** (in days, weeks, and years.)
- ⇒ **Vaccination Summary** - lists all valid immunizations that the student has received; invalid doses will not be listed in the vaccination summary section
- ⇒ **Vaccine Forecast** - lists all the immunizations the student is past due and or coming due for, and includes:

Vaccine type

Dose number in series

Recommended date of administration (based on the routine, age-based immunization schedule as set by the Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices (ACIP))

Minimum valid date (earliest date the immunization can be given and still be counted as a valid dose)

- ⇒ **Comments** relating to invalid doses and immunization exemptions

Note: If there are exemptions in a student's record, the forecaster will no longer recommend any doses of that vaccine.
