Our specially trained team works with people who have low vision or are blind to reach their career goals. Some Employment Services Include:

- **Career guidance and counseling**
  - One-on-one support to guide you toward a career path.
- **Career exploration**
  - Learn about your interests and different jobs.
- **On-the-job training**
  - Gain skills and experience while you are working.
- **Assistive technology**
  - Learn and use special tools (e.g. magnifier, JAWs, etc.) to succeed on the job.
- **Job site modifications**
  - See if your workplace is accessible and if assistive technology can help with your job.
- **Information and referral**
  - Find out about other helpful resources and services.
- **Independent living skills**
  - Learn skills to live and work on your own.

Funding for this was provided through a combination of Federal funds awarded by the U.S. Department of Education under the State Vocational Rehabilitation Services (VR) program and State appropriated funds. Federal funds pay for 78.7% of the program costs. For FFY 2023, the VR agency was awarded \$12,082,440 in Federal VR funds. The remaining 21.3% of funding of \$3,270,089 was provided by State appropriated funds.

## Older Individuals Who are Blind (OIB) Program

Vocational Rehabilitation helps people with low vision or who are blind improve their independence and safety in their homes and communities.

### Program Requirements:

- Be aged 55 and older
- Have a vision impairment like macular degeneration, glaucoma, cataracts, etc.
- Not live in a nursing home

### Some OIB Services Include:

- Assistive Technology Devices and Training
  - Magnifier, lights, glare control
- Communication Skills

- Large print calendars, watches/clocks, computer training
- Daily Living Skills
  - Meal preparation, clothing care, leisure activities, grooming
- Low Vision Assessment
- Information and Referral to Other Programs
  - Talking Books, ND Assistive, ND Vision Services/School for the Blind, etc.

Federal funds pay for 90% of the program costs. For FFY 2024, the Vocational Rehabilitation agency was awarded \$225,000 in Federal OIB funds. The remaining 10% of funding of \$25,000 was provided by State appropriated funds.
