



ANXIETY DISORDER SELECTED WITH ANOTHER CONDITION(S)


- 32% Anxiety Disorder and PTSD
 - Anxiety Disorder, PTSD, and another condition(s) selected increases to 45%
- 10% Anxiety Disorder and Spinal Stenosis/Chronic Back Pain
- 7% Anxiety Disorder and Migraine
- 7% Anxiety Disorder and Severe Debilitating Pain
- 5% Anxiety Disorder and Fibromyalgia

TYPES OF USABLE MARIJUANA

Not for Minors! (under 19)

*Products with >6% THC

*Smokable form



DRIED LEAVES AND FLOWER PURCHASE LIMIT AND INFORMATION

Types

- Regular
- B bud
- Trim

Maximum purchase amount per 30 days:

2.5 ounces

(up to 6 ounces of dried leaves and flowers may be authorized for patients with a medical condition of cancer)

Sizes

- 1 gram
- 1/8 (3.5 grams)
- 1/4 (7 grams)

Pre-rolls

- Three 1 gram
- Five 0.7 gram

MEDICAL MARIJUANA PRODUCTS PURCHASE LIMIT AND INFORMATION

Maximum purchase amount per 30 days:

4,000 mg of THC

Types

- Concentrates
 - Includes waxes, shatters, live resin, PDO/RSO, distillate vapes
 - 1/2 gram and 1 gram containers/syringes/vape cartridges
- Solutions
- Capsules
- Topicals/Lotions/Roll-Ons
- Transdermal Patches (not to market at this time)

REPORT REQUIREMENTS - NDCC SECTION 19-24.1-39

Annually, the department shall submit to the legislative management a report that does not disclose any identifying information about registered cardholders, compassion centers, or health care providers, but contains the following information:

1. The number of registry identification card applications and renewals;
2. The number of registered qualifying patients, registered designated caregivers, and registered compassion center agents;

REPORT REQUIREMENTS - NDCC SECTION 19-24.1-39

3. The nature of the debilitating medical conditions of the registered qualifying patients;
4. The number of registry identification cards revoked;
5. The number of health care providers providing written certifications for qualifying patients;
6. The number of compassion centers;
7. Any expenses incurred and revenues generated by the department from the medical marijuana program; and
8. Data for statistical purposes in a manner so that an individual person is not identifiable.

VOLUNTARY DEMOGRAPHIC INFORMATION IN APPLICATION

Qualifying patient applications include a 'Voluntary Demographic Information' section (date of birth is a mandatory field in the application). Information requested includes:

- Sex
- Race
- Veteran
- Education Level
- Occupation
- Income Level
- Healthcare Coverage
