

Mountrail County Opioid Settlement Spend Plan

In collaboration with the Upper Missouri District Health Unit and the North Central Human Service Center Settlements, Mountrail County is a participant in the following National Opioids Settlements:

Payments

Mountrail County has received Distributor, Manufacturer, and Pharmacy payments totaling \$ 12,624.80 as of July 1, 2025.

Additional payments may be received through Consultant McKinsey & Company, Inc.'s settlement, but additional information about the County's entitlement to any Consultant payments has not yet been received as of this date.

Spend Plan

At this time, Mountrail County has not yet determined a Spend Plan. Mountrail County plans to work with the Upper Missouri District Health Unit (UMDHU), the North Central Human Service Center (NCHSC), Bob Hayes (Licensed Addiction Counselor) and other local stakeholders to develop a comprehensive plan. It is Mountrail County's understanding that UMDHU will be focusing on opioid prevention through other grant means. Further, it is Mountrail County's understanding that NCHSC and Bob Hayes will be focusing on fulfilling treatment needs in addition to private providers in the county, Mountrail County will likely focus the settlement dollars on recovery and support activities that are within the approved spend parameters of the settlement. Additionally, until the final settlement amounts from the Pharmacy Settlements and the Consultant McKinsey & Company settlement are determined, Mountrail County is unable to identify the full scope of activities.
