

WELLS COUNTY OPIOID SETTLEMENT ALLOCATION PLAN

Wells County District Health Unit (WCDHU) has been providing prevention services in response to the opioid crisis since 2018. Funds received through ND DHS and HRSA have allowed us to provide education and awareness, distribute and provide education on Narcan, contract with All of Us in Recovery (AIR) to provide recovery support services, and provide curriculum taught by our prevention coordinator to our local schools. These services have had a great impact in our county.

We intend to use the Subdivision Opioid Settlement funds to further maintain our contracts with AIR and local schools providing the keepin' it REAL (Refuse. Explain. Avoid. Leave) curriculum:

- Wells County District Health Unit will contract with All of Us in Recovery to provide recovery support services to individuals in Wells County either through in person meetings or "telehealth" support such as telephone or Facetime/Zoom/Teams/etc. during times when Face to Face interactions cannot be achieved.
- Wells County District Health Unit will contract with the school allowing WCDHU prevention coordinator to teach keepin' it REAL prevention curriculum. The funds would be for preparation to teach and in classroom teaching.

Wells County District Health Unit will be sending this allocation plan to the Wells County Auditor (Dan Stutlien) for approval by the Wells County Commission.
