

Each Recovery Housing Assistance Program (RHAP) participant has the right to:

- 1. Not be discriminated against based on race, ethnicity, medical conditions, sexual orientation, disability, or religion
- 2. Be provided an environment that is conducive to recovery and free from alcohol and illicit substances
- 3. Have choice regarding your recovery path
- **4.** Be allowed access to prescription medication including Medication Assisted Treatment (MAT)

- **5.** Have access to someone from the organization 24/7
- **6.** Be able to continue residency after conclusion of the RHAP program
- 7. Not be charged rental fees while being a participant of the RHAP program
