## Accessing the SUD Voucher

How do I apply?

## Eligibility

- 1 The individual resides in North Dakota
- 2 The individual is 12 years of age or older
- 3 The individual does not have resources to pay for treatment and one of the following:
  - a. The individual's third party payment resource will not cover all costs of treatment; or
  - b. The individual has a pending application for medical assistance which presents a barrier to timely access to treatment; or
  - c. The individual does not qualify for medical assistance and has no alternative third party payment resources
- 4 The individual has an annual income no greater than 200% of federal poverty guidelines (FPG):

In certain circumstances, the SUD Voucher Program may allow an exception to the income requirements when the individual is over the 200% FPG.
