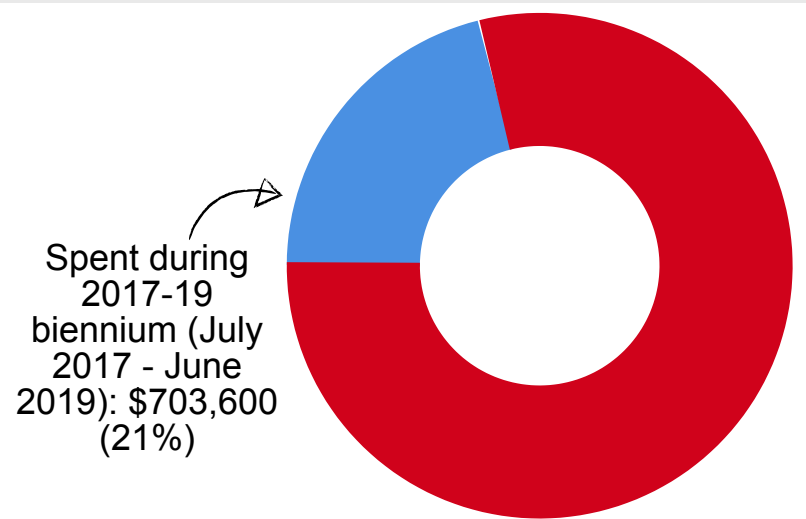
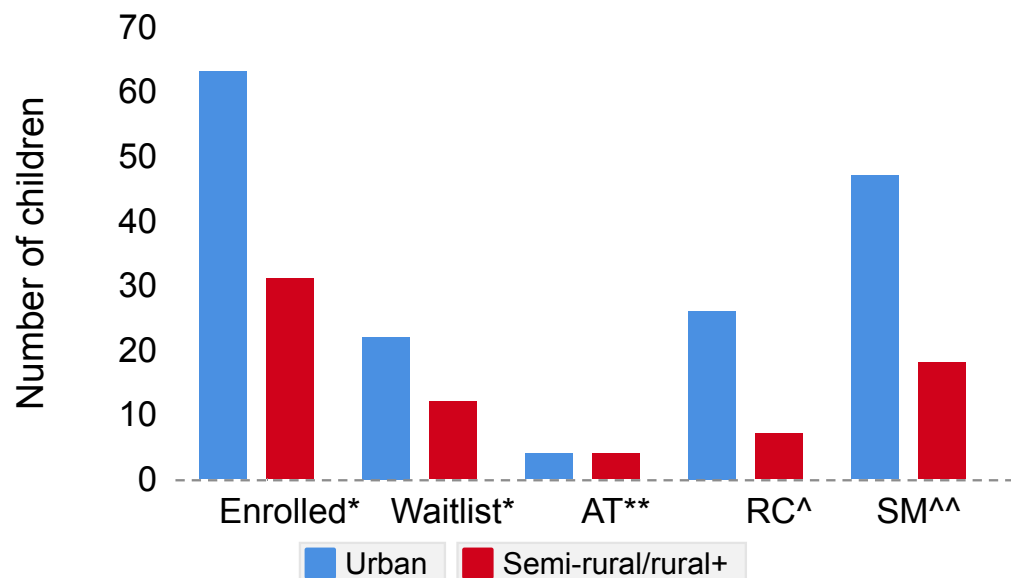

Autism Spectrum Disorder Services 2017-2019 Biennium (July 2017-June 2019)

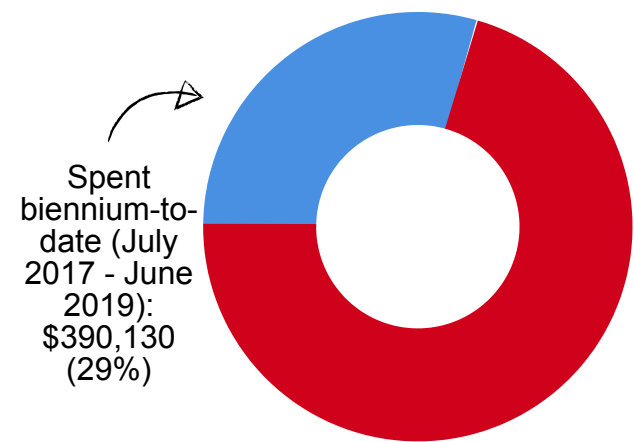
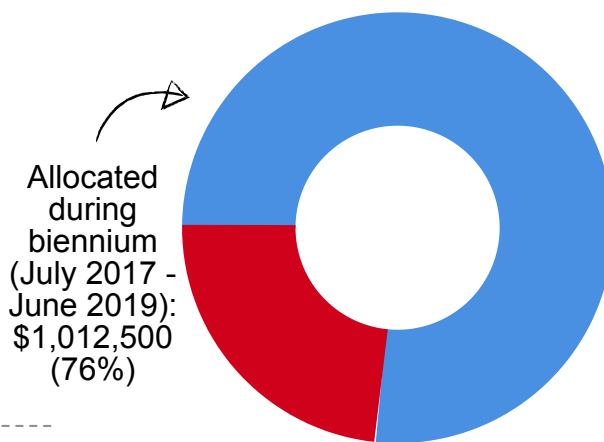
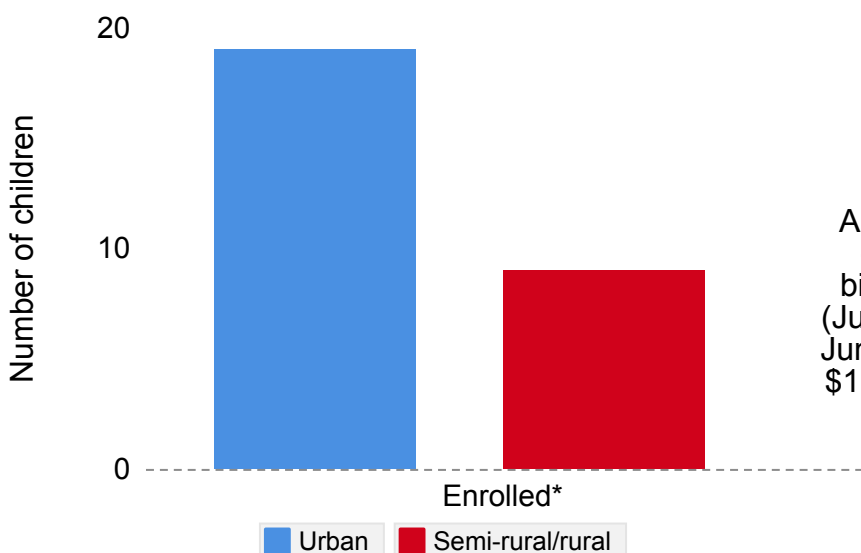

Total appropriation (2017-19 biennium): \$3,363,979

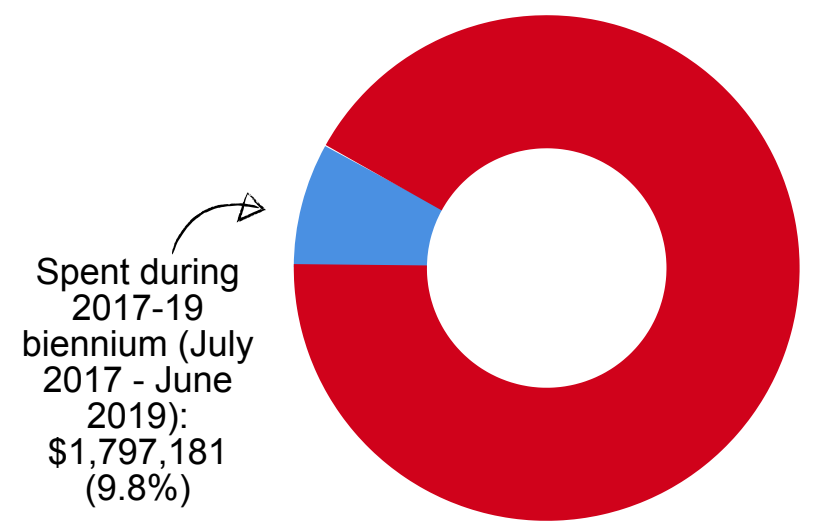
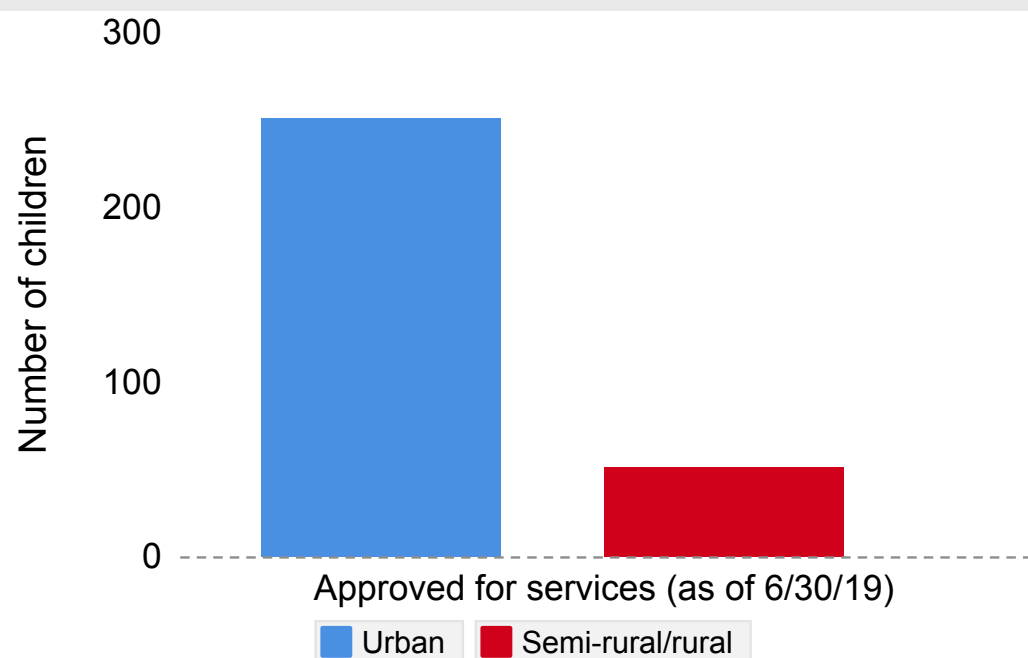
Enrollment/Utilization for April-June 2019
