

## Public comment sought on draft 2022-2026 State Plan on Aging

The North Dakota Department of Human Services' Aging Services Division is accepting public comments on the new Older Americans Act State Plan on Aging that covers the period beginning Oct. 1, 2022, through Sept. 30, 2026.

The State Plan on Aging with the use of Older Americans Act funds pays for a variety of services such as information and assistance through the Aging & Disability Resource Link (ADRL), congregate and home-delivered meals, legal assistance, assistive safety devices, health maintenance services, and falls prevention programs that allows older individuals to remain living in their homes and communities.
