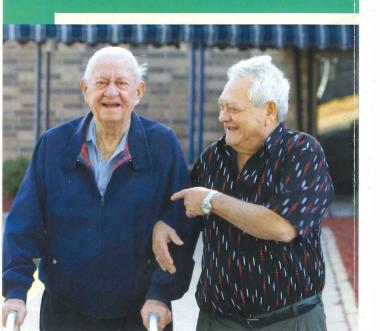

SENIOR COMPANION

As a volunteer companion you will:

- · Do something meaningful and fun
- Be an ongoing friend, advocate, and resource for an older adult
- Complete specialized training that includes orientation, team meetings, and workshops
- Receive an hourly tax-free stipend plus mileage reimbursement
- You may also receive a meal allowance





How do Companions Provide Support?

Companions usually visit each older adult for a few hours each week and:

- Assist with correspondence and simple household tasks
- Provide transportation to medical appointments, grocery shopping and errands
- Offer encouragement, support, and advocacy to an older adult
- Act as a member of the support team that helps keep older adults healthy and living independently
- Share hobbies and interests such as playing cards

- A non-taxable stipend of \$4 per hour
 (volunteer 10+ hours per week to qualify)
