North Dakota State Plan of Operation Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program Federal Fiscal Year (FFY) 2023

The N.D. Department of Human Services is requesting public comments on the FFY 2023 Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program State Plan. The current draft plan can be viewed online at www.nd.gov/dhs/services/financialhelp/energyassist.html.
