### Cabinet Discussion on Proposed Recommendations – Senator Heckaman

- Janell Regimbal proposed some language changes to Cabinet's recommendations.
  - Add in "Collaborate with colleges to provide year-long paid internships for credit. Increased funding for paid training opportunities for residential and shelter-related staff, recognizing that in a workforce shortage situation it often requires overtime pay."
  - Add "provide incentives and reduce barriers for providers to engage in providing evidence-based services related to FFPSA funding streams."
