Department of Human Services Updates

- A 2021 Legislative Session Recap was provided.
- The 1915(i) State Plan Amendment for Community-Based Behavioral Health Services was
 discussed, specifically the WHODAS score to meet eligibility. The Department is collecting deidentified WHODAS scores from any provider who can submit them to us. We are evaluating if a
 change is needed to the score and this data will help us to decide if the score should be lowered.

Discussion
