## RE: 1915(c) Medicaid waiver amendment applications

This letter is regarding Tribal Consultation established between the North Dakota Department of Human Services and the North Dakota Indian Tribes. This consultation process was established to ensure Tribal governments are included in the decision-making processes when changes in the Medicaid or Children's Health Insurance Program(s) will affect items such as cost or reductions and additions to the program.

This letter provides the opportunity for consultation on one waiver amendment.

## Proposed amendment to Medicaid Waiver for Home and Community Based Services (HCBS):

The-Department's Aging Services Division proposes to amend the 1915(c) Medicaid waiver. The purpose of this amendment is to implement the rate increase approved in HB 1012 (DHS appropriations bill) for the 2021-2023 biennium and implement strategies included in the DOJ Settlement Agreement to increase access to home and community-based services. The amendment includes changes to family personal care, residential habilitation, community supports, supervision, environmental modification, non-medical transportation and companionship services, and planned effective date in the financial management section of the waiver. The amendment will also make changes to the rate methodology for Non-Medical Transportation, Non-Medical Transportation (Escort), Supervision and Family Personal Care to attract providers for these waiver services.

The anticipated effective date of the proposed renewal is expected to be January 1, 2022.
