Updates

Krissie Guerard:

O The Health Equity (HE) office just completed a 31.8 million dollar 2 year grant that will begin June 1, 2021. This grant will be particular to HE and COVID. Within the grant, there is a lot of infrastructure building. A big part of the grant is to do some rural health grants to rural communities and funding for their projects; UND infrastructure building in critical care; NDSU tribal area; and a big portion to LPHU for them to do a health equity strategic plan for their specific areas. HE office will be hiring someone to manage the grant. Also, will be hiring someone to handle the communication aspect of the grant, a new NFI health liaison, and four tribal health liaisons, but those will come out of a different grant source. \$50,000 was written in for each of the HE Boards. Each Board will be able to do a project that is HE and COVID-related.
