

- CSC (Comprehensive Stroke Center) Meets all functions of the PSC+ with the ability to provide 24/7 neurosurgery and neuroendovascular interventions, neuro dedicated ICU, and full spectrum of hemorrhagic stroke care (microsurgical neurovascular clipping of aneurysms, neuroendovascular coiling of aneurysms, stenting of extracranial carotid arteries, carotid endarterectomy). Maintains stroke disease specific certification by a national certification body.
- TSC (Thrombectomy-Capable Stroke Center, includes Primary Stroke Center Plus) Meets all the functions of the PSC with the ability to provide access to CT, MRI, labs, CTA, MRA & catheter angiography 24/7; other cranial and carotid duplex ultrasound, TEE as indicated, Neurointerventionist, mechanical thrombectomy, & IA thrombolytics. Maintains stroke disease specific certification by a national certification body.
- PSC (Primary Stroke Center) Meets all the functions of the ASRH plus has stroke designated beds, acute stroke team available 24/7 ability to provide medical management of stroke patients. Access to MRI, MRA, CT, CTA, cardiac imaging, and a Neurologist in-person or via telestroke. Maintains stroke disease specific certification by a national certification body.
- ASRH (Acute Stroke Ready Hospital) Designated by the State of North Dakota, ability to provide rapid stroke assessment, CT (computed tomography), access to IV thrombolytics, coordination of transfer to a most appropriate stroke center.
