This document includes COVID-19 vaccination guidance for children and adolescents ages 6 months through 4 years. Currently, children less than 6 months of age are not authorized to receive COVID-19 vaccine.

COVID-19 Vaccine Decision Tree

Updated Pfizer Series for Children Ages 6 months - 4 years

PFIZER-BIONTECH

How many doses of any Pfizer vaccine has the patient previously received?

0 doses

Administer 3 doses of **2024-2025** Pfizer. The first two doses are administered three weeks apart. Dose 3 is administered at least 8 weeks after 2nd dose.

1 dose

Administer 2 doses of **2024-2025** Pfizer. The first dose is administered three weeks after the initial dose. Dose 3 is administered at least 8 weeks after 2nd dose.

2 doses

Administer 1 dose of **2024-2025** Pfizer 8 weeks after previous dose

3+ doses

Administer 1 dose of **2024-2025** Pfizer at least 2 months after previous dose
