COVID TASK FORCE UPDATE

- The NFI Advisory Board has had a unique opportunity use \$50,000 of COVID funding to improve the lives of NFI in North Dakota!
- The COVID Task force was convened in 2021 and met weekly.
- They identified that doing three events focused on convening NFI, especially youth, would help improve the isolation many felt from COVID.
- Three project areas were identified: one in Bismarck, Grand Forks, and Minot and NFI Advisory Board members had the opportunity to lead the projects.
- The Grand Forks project was led by United African Community; one event took place last year and another will happen this year.
 - We will give you an update next time on this project!
- Due to lack of NFI Project host, the Minot project was moved and will likely happy in Williston; money needs to be spent by May 31, 2024.
- Bismarck Global Neighbors is leading the Bismarck project; Ruth will share about it next.
