### Health Literacy Project & TikTok Update, Kiamya Philson

### The Campaign, Katarina Domitrovich & Hannah Anderson

- Doing a campaign on five different topics that the youth put forward: sexual health, financial health, mental health, immunizations and COVID, physical health and nutrition.
- Partnered with Kat and Company to develop scripts led by this board.

- Scripts were sent out for the five areas and asked the board to review and looking for some feedback:
  - One opinion was that it was cheesy and cringey.
  - This was a good starting point but maybe change the wording.
  - One member was confused by who the script was directed at.
  - Teacher in all the scripts seemed too goofy to be taken seriously.
  - The way the students were talking to the teacher didn't sounds good.
  - The immunization script claims of vaccination definition.
  - o Could a small committee be created to sit in on the meeting with Kat and Company?
  - "We all got the feels," from the mental health script sounds strange.
  - o "Disney channel sitcom."

### Mental Health Task Force, YMCA Event & YAB Transition, Krissie Guerard
