<u>Approval of Minutes:</u> Janna made motion to approve and JuLann seconded. Minutes approved.

<u>Updates</u>

- New task force members were announced.
- Division of EMS updates
 - Awarded 3.4 million for the next 3 years from the Helmsley Trust
 - Approximately 1700 AEDs will be distributed around the state
 - Working on training and distribution plan for the Helmsley AED project
 - Cardiac System of Care working on developing designation criteria
 - Century code requires STEMI Receiving and STEMI referring
 - Cardiac Ready Community Program-UND is the 13th CRC to be added. Bismarck/Mandan and Fargo/West Fargo applications are under review. There are 30 communities working towards designation
 - Trauma system expanded reimbursement for training TNCC
 - EMS System of Care-rewriting personnel licensure rules
 - o Trauma rules through the Attorney General to public comment
 - EMSC is rolling out pediatric champion program

EMS Stroke Protocol

- Looking for recommendations from the task force.
- Check balance and eyes. Add posterior.
- Provide examples of BEFAST
- Joint commission Cincinnati Scale.
- ASLS -severity scoring-FAST ED, others using RACE and VAN
- Rural places do FAST ED
- o Suggestion for Stroke Assessment is to keep it simple. Cincinnati and BEFAST.
- o It is important to support education, educate on one tool so we are speaking the same language
- Task Force suggests FAST ED, work with hospitals to speak same language
- NIH Severity score for ALS. AHA promotes FAST ED
- BEFAST not supported for public awareness, used as assessment tool
- o Mindy recommends the state EMS protocols consider adding posterior screening
- Next biennium for stroke budget
- This is Janna's last meeting and then she will hand over some processes to Christine.
- Still have materials so any ideas on how to use up funding.
