

The Advanced Hazmat Life Support Provider/Instructor course aims to equip healthcare providers (EMS, Paramedics, Nurses, PAs, MDs, etc.) with the ability to medically manage patients exposed to hazardous materials. The course consists of 2 days of hazmat training and an additional half-day for participants interested in becoming course instructors.

Mountain Plains Regional Disaster Health Response System (MPRDHRS) is **covering the cost of registration and materials for attendees from Region VIII (CO, WY, UT, MT, SD, and ND)** with the goal of training instructors who will be able to support future grant-funded AHLS courses.
