2. You should consider doing the following infection control measures:

3. You should always know the contact time for the disinfectant that you are using.

Answer Key: 1. D (to protect you and to prevent germ spread; use an EPA-approved disinfectant and observe contact times), 2. D (it is important to deep clean carpet at least yearly and more often is better-especially in high traffic areas) 3. A (knowing and observing the contact time for the disinfectant that you are using is critical to ensuring maximum germ kill)
