Increased risk of germs and germ spread in all healthcare settings,

What are the most common HAIs?

- ★ Catheter- associated urinany tract infections
- **★** Surgical site infections
- **Bloodstream infections**
- **P**neumonia
- Antibiotic-resistant germs may make treatment difficult

Why

Why do we need to be concerned about HAIs?

- ★ Germs and the infections that they cause can travel between facilities
- ★ Healthcare clients die from HAIs
- **HAIs** can be prevented



Steps you can take

Hand Hygiene:

★ Proper hand hygiene reduces the spread of potientially deadly germs to patients

Report any signs of infection:

- Redness
- **★** Pain
- **★** Drainage at the incision site or the tube site
- **Fever**
