- ★ Catheter- associated urinany tract infections
- **Surgical site infections**
- **★** Bloodstream infections
- **★** Pneumonia
- Antibiotic-resistant germs may make treatment difficult

Why

Why do we need to be concerned about HAIs?

- ★ Germs and the infections that they cause can travel between facilities
- **★** Healthcare clients die from HAIs
- * HAIs can be prevented

Steps you can take

Hand Hygiene:

Proper hand hygiene reduces the spread of potientially deadly germs to patients

Report any signs of infection:

- * redness
- nain pain
- drainage at the incision site or the tube site
- **fever**
