





Open Position - Chair

Chair. The Chair shall:

- a. Carry out responsibilities of leadership for the NDCC;
- b. When present, convene and preside at all meetings of the executive board and of members, and assign coalition members to do the same over committee meetings;
- c. See that all orders and resolutions of the executive board are carried into effect;
- d. Sign and deliver in the name of the NDCC, any contracts or other instruments pertaining to the business of the NDCC, except in cases in which the authority to sign and deliver is required by law to be exercised by another person or is expressly delegated by the executive board to some officer or agent of the NDCC;
- e. Assist with setting meeting agendas and priorities;
- f. Promote collaboration, encourage shared responsibility, share ideas and recommendations, and be open to diverse points of view;
- g. Appoint or reconvene any committee, as needed, to provide advice on priority cancer sites or issues, which may include persons who are not NDCC members; and
- f. Perform other duties prescribed by the executive committee.


Chair Nominee – Julie Garden-Robinson

Julie Garden-Robinson, PhD, RD, LRD, is a professor and Extension Food and Nutrition Specialist at North Dakota State University. She has served on the North Dakota Cancer Coalition since 2011 and on the Steering Committee since 2012. Julie has implemented statewide educational programs using a variety of strategies for more than 10 years related to cancer, especially skin cancer and colon cancer. "Healthwise" programs focusing on cancer awareness have been recognized nationally and other states are using the materials. "On the Move to Better Health" programs reach thousands of children annually in school and afterschool programs with sun safety and nutrition information.

Julie has served on several boards in leadership capacities, including four years on the National Extension Association of Family and Consumer Sciences Board and more than 20 years on the North Dakota Nutrition Council. Julie has experienced the loss of family and friends due to cancer; therefore, she is committed to increasing the awareness of lifestyle factors and screening related to cancer risk prevention. She would look forward to expanding the network to reach more North Dakotans with potentially life-saving information.

Open Position – Vice Chair




