

Electronic ID Cards:

Electronic ID cards may be used the same way in which a printed ID card is used. Once the Medical Marijuana Program has issued and printed the card, the electronic ID card will also be available for use. Cardholders can use either their electronic or printed ID card whenever they want. However, cardholders may want to check with dispensaries regarding their policies and procedures related to electronic cards and the check-in process.

How to Access the Electronic ID Card:

Cardholders can login to the registration system from their mobile device using this link https://mmregistration.health.nd.gov/ or by visiting the Medical Marijuana Program website https://www.hhs.nd.gov/mm.

Once logged in, the electronic ID card will automatically appear. If it doesn't, click on this icon:



The first screen will be the front of the ID card:

Leaves/Flower Possession Limits: Standard = 3.0 oz Enhanced = 7.5 oz

Registered qualifying patients and designated caregivers can possess an unlimited amount of concentrates (such as vape pens/cartridges, wax, shatter, budder, RSO, PDO, etc.), cannabinoid solutions, capsules, potches, and topicals. Cannabinoid edible product possession limit is 500 MG of THC.
