

If a minor patient turns 19 years old prior to their minor patient ID card expiring, there are two options:

- The patient can keep the minor ID card until the expiration date. This would limit the patient to pediatric products only and would still require the patient to have a designated caregiver to purchase product on their behalf. Or,
- The patient can complete a non-minor patient application. This would require the following:
  - The health care provider to submit a new written certification
  - The \$25 application fee. Once paid this fee is non-refundable.
  - The patient to determine whether or not they wish to have a designated caregiver. If they wish to have a designated caregiver, the designated caregiver must also complete a new application (see designated caregiver application instructions).
