

Application/ID Card Renewal Process:

It is the cardholder's responsibility to renew their application/ID card prior to the expiration date. For sufficient processing time, and to prevent interruption of possessing a valid ID card, a cardholder must renew their application at least 45 days prior to the expiration date of their existing ID card.

To renew an application, log into the registration system using this link <https://mmregistration.health.nd.gov>, or visit the Division of Medical Marijuana website www.health.nd.gov/mm.

After logging in, the applicant will have the option to renew their application by clicking the "renewal" button:

Once the applicant clicks renewal, a new application will open. Much of the information from the original application will auto-populate into the new application. The applicant can modify or change any information they would like in the new application prior to submitting it.

Because this is a renewal, the applicant should now answer "yes" to this question:

Do you currently possess a North Dakota Medical Marijuana Registry ID Card

Yes No

Some areas, including signatures and dates, will not auto-populate and the applicant must enter that information again.

Once the applicant has successfully completed all required fields, a blue "submit" button will appear at the bottom of the application, and the applicant can submit their renewal.



All renewal applications have the same requirements as the original application including the application fee. For patients, the health care provider must complete a new written certification. If a patient has a designated caregiver, the designated caregiver must also renew their application.
