<p><b>Roundtable Mission and Overview</b></p>	<p>80% by 2018 initiative – what is happening nationwide? Dr. Wender - public health initiative has been successful and they will use for other cancers. Colorectal cancer screening rates are increasing. FQHC increase by 4%. We won't have full numbers until 2020. Tracking measures- BRFSS, NIHS, HEDIS measures (insurance measure) UDS – HRSA reported. Lessons learned- evidence based interventions- move policy and system changes. Stool testing is needed. Primary care is key, navigation is important, champions are needed. Paying for colorectal cancer navigation tool kit- can be used for all screenings. Best practice book for healthcare plan. Business case to do this and how to implement a PTO for screening. Started with cancer screening but now increased to more screenings. Washington State and NY have plans- tool kit draft done – need to put in readable format. Coordinate other activities with other groups such as Blue Alliance. (monthly meetings).  Provider education and support- increasing screening rates. A champion makes a difference. Start small work in rural settings – strategies to increase screening rates.  FluFIT group- system change – ND and SD were doing the same thing – series of Webinar for the GPQIN. Kansas and Nebraska were added. GPTCHB added- 57 clinics across 4 states. Standing orders were important for all clients. Billing questions with forms and codes.</p>

FIT tests that were available and which were recommended.</p> <p>Currently collecting data from a survey with numbers and what were barriers and what made it successful.</p> <p>GPQIN congratulations 2017 Honoree- achievement award 80% by 2018.</p> <p>Partner success improving CRC rates- GPTCHB successes. Serve 18 tribes – currently working with 12 communities sub awards - 6.4 % increase in screening rates. Outreach in March – Rollin Colon – pre/post tests.</p> <p>Sanford Health nurse driven colorectal cancer screening.</p> <p>Walsh County sub contract focus awareness for colorectal cancer prevention. Media – clinics champion that would do radio ads- 7 clinics participating.
