COVID-19 Doses Administered Report

Getting Started

The COVID-19 Doses Administered report provides a printable PDF document of all doses of COVID-19 vaccine administered by a provider site. The report shows aggregated total numbers of doses administered by age group and type of immunization.

How to Run a COVID-19 Doses Administered Report:

1.) To access this report, select the '**Pandemic**' category from the **Reports** drop-down, then select '**COVID-19 Doses Administered**' in the '**Select Report**' drop-down. The report will open to the **Selection Criteria**.



2.) Select your provider site from the **Provider** drop-down. This report can only be run for one provider site at a time.

3.) If you want to refine by dose date, enter the earliest dose date you want included in **From Date** and the final dose date you want included in **To Date**. If the dose date boxes are not populated, the report will include all doses of COVID-19 vaccine administered.

4.) Users can chose to include all doses (both valid and invalid) or only valid doses by using the **Validity** drop-down. This field will default to run for all doses.

5.) After all criteria are defined, click Run.

6.) The completed report and all previous reports of this type can be viewed in the report **History** tab.
