## A. Purpose

This policy outlines grant eligibility and application requirements for specific funds appropriated to the Division of Emergency Medical Systems (the Division) to administer to level I or II hospitals for coordinating a Rural Trauma Team Development Course (RTTDC) for level IV or V trauma designated hospitals with the intention of reducing financial barriers associated with RTTDC training to make trauma skills training more accessible for rural healthcare providers.

## B. Grant Eligibility and Application Requirements

- Coordination of a RTTDC course must be completed by a level I or II hospital to assist with training of rural healthcare providers in level IV or V trauma designated hospitals.
- Submit to the Division a completed application form entitled "Rural Trauma Team Development Course Coordination Reimbursement" (SFN 60480) as provided by the Division.
- A copy of each of the following must be submitted with the completed application form:
  - Signed participant roster
  - Course agenda including the following information:
    - Name of hospital
    - City
    - Date of course
    - Name of instructor(s) utilized

## C. Disbursement

- Disbursement in the amount of \$6,250.00 may be made by the Division to a requesting hospital provided the eligibility and application requirements are met in their entirety.
- Suggested reimbursement amounts for funds provided by the Division to the applying hospital are as follows:

Course Coordinator	\$ 900	
Nurse/Paramedic Instructors	\$ 400 each	
Physician Instructors	\$1000 each	
Equipment/Textbooks/Mileage/Additional Expenses	Remainder of funds/in-kind	

Grants will be distributed in the order complete and eligible applications are received by the Division until all grant funds have been dispersed.
