# Uniting for Ukraine (U4U) Program in North Dakota

## Who are the beneficiaries of Uniting for Ukraine? Are they eligible for help?

In response to the war in Ukraine and the resulting refugee crisis, the U.S. Department of Homeland Security is granting temporary safe harbor to vetted Ukrainians permitting them to legally enter the U.S. These Ukrainian guests who arrive between Feb. 24, 2022, and Sept. 30, 2023, are eligible to apply for Medicaid, Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP), Supplemental Security Income (SSI), Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) and other programs and must qualify. This supports a positive transition to their new community. They are also eligible for Refugee Support Services, including employment support and English Language Learning. Their spouses or unmarried children under age 21 who are also allowed to legally enter the U.S. after Sept. 30, 2023, are also eligible to apply for benefits and must meet program eligibility criteria to qualify.

### Federal Office of Refugee Resettlement Fact Sheet on Benefits for Ukrainians

#### When should I apply for public benefits and Refugee Support Services?

Apply <u>now</u>. Do not wait. Office of Refugee Resettlement (ORR)-funded cash and medical assistance are limited to a maximum of 12 months from your date of eligibility (May 21, 2022, or the date you arrived at a U.S. Port of Entry whichever is later). If you entered the United States between Feb. 24, 2022 and May 21, 2022, the date of eligibility is May 21, 2022.

Ukrainian guests are also eligible for Refugee Support Services (RSS). These services include employment, case management, English language learning, and vocational and skills training. Lutheran Immigration and Refugee Service (LIRS) in Fargo is the eastern North Dakota provider and Bismarck Global Neighbors (BGN) is the western North Dakota provider.
