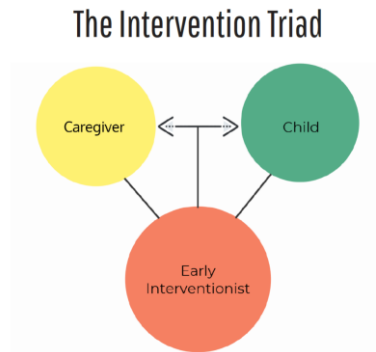

Questions to consider while watching each video:

- In what ways did “being there” with the family, in their everyday routines, activities, and places, help the service provider to focus on triadic strategies?
- How was this a good example of the use of a triadic strategy?
- In what ways were the triadic strategies used meaningful to the family?
- How did the early interventionist actively engage the caregivers in the routines?
- What techniques did the early interventionist use (e.g. demonstration, teaching, coaching, etc.)?
- What else could the early interventionist have done to encourage interactions and connections between the child and caregiver?
