



HOUSING PROVIDERS: BREATHE A SIGH OF RENT RELIEF.

Are you a housing provider with renters who need help with rent and utilities?
Apply to see if you qualify to have payments sent directly to you from ND Rent Help.

DOCUMENTS TO HAVE WHEN YOU APPLY:

- Government-issued photo ID (if registering as an individual, not a company)
- Proof of property ownership
- Supplier ID and Company ID from ND OMB vendor registration
- Lease agreement
- Information about past-due rent and other charges
- Information about rental assistance renter is receiving from a different program (if applicable)

RENTERS: BREATHE A SIGH OF RENT RELIEF.

Need help with your rent and utilities? Apply to see if you qualify for assistance from ND Rent Help.

DOCUMENTS TO HAVE WHEN YOU APPLY:

- Government-issued photo ID
- Lease agreement
- Documentation showing how much you owe your housing provider for past rent, late fees, etc.
- At least one of the following forms of proof of current income:
 - 2020 tax return
 - 1099 form
 - Two most recent paystubs
- Any determination letter from unemployment insurance (dated March 13, 2020 or later)
- Eviction court hearing notice or eviction notice from housing provider
- Approval letters from other income-tested programs (since January 2020), such as: HUD, Medicaid, WIC, Head Start, or other
 - Note: Providing this information may help speed up our review of your application as we can accept eligibility from other approved federal programs.*
- Copy of your past-due utility bill(s)
 - Must show address of rental housing
 - Must show billing breakdown

HOUSEHOLDS EXPERIENCING HOMELESSNESS: BREATHE A SIGH OF RENT RELIEF.

Are you experiencing homelessness or in a temporary living situation? Apply to see if you qualify for temporary housing assistance from ND Rent Help.

DOCUMENTS TO HAVE WHEN YOU APPLY:

- Government-issued photo ID
- Proof of current income (if available), such as: 2020 tax return, 1099 form, or two most recent paystubs
- Approval letters from other income-tested programs (since January 2020), such as: HUD, Medicaid, WIC, Head Start, or other
- Any determination letter from unemployment insurance (dated March 13, 2020 or later)
- Copies of any past-due amount to a previous housing provider or utility company

Note: Providing this information may help speed up our review of your application as we can accept eligibility from other approved federal programs.
