

I got an approval email for NDRH Housing Stabilization assistance! What do I do now?

Now that you have been approved for assistance, you will receive an email and call from your Housing Stability Coach or Housing Facilitator with next steps. When you get in touch with your Housing Stability Coach you will go over the following:

- Letter of Commitment and Lease Training
- Reading a Lease Training

Once you have completed training with your coach, you will be asked to login to your portal to acknowledge that you have completed and understand the Letter of Commitment and Lease Training. At this time, you will be issued a Letter of Commitment to find stable housing.

When you are ready to submit your housed application, you will need:

- Government-issued photo ID (if available)
- Occumentation of most recent income if this has changed since your Housing Stability Application
- Signed lease agreement
- Ledger (itemized list of outstanding rental charges broken down by month)
- Signed Letter of Commitment
