

Housing Stabilization Application Checklist

Are you or anyone in your household experiencing homelessness or are at imminent risk of homelessness? Apply to see if you qualify for temporary housing assistance from NDRH Housing Stabilization.

Homelessness: an individual or family who lacks a fixed, regular, adequate nighttime residence. This includes a living situation where you are temporarily doubled up with another household.

Imminent risk of homelessness: an individual or family with an eviction hearing scheduled within the next 30 days. Does not include households with an initial 3-day eviction notice or lease termination notice.

Documents to have when you apply:

- Government-issued photo ID (if available)
- Social Security Number for all household members over 18
- Proof of current income (if available), such as:
 - Most recent tax returns
 - Most recent 1099
 - Two most recent paystubs
- Copies of any past-due amount to a previous housing provider or utility company that is causing a barrier to housing (if applicable)
