

NDWORKS: The work program associated with Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program that provides individuals opportunities to overcome barriers, gain skills, training or experience, and participate in job search activities that will improve your employment prospects and reduce your reliance on SNAP benefits.

- You will have to comply with 12 hours per month of Job Searching or Job Search Training, 30 hours per week of employment or be enrolled in an education program.
- You will have to maintain weekly contact with your Service Coordinator, with at least one in-person meeting per month.

SUPPORTIVE SERVICES AVAILABLE: NDWORKS program participants are eligible for reimbursements if they have an open SNAP case. The following items are included:

- Transportation (bus pass, fares, vouchers, gas, taxi fees)
- Grooming and personal hygiene
- Clothing and tools for employment
- Licensing and testing for employment
- Books and training materials necessary for educational component
