





Gaps in children's vocabulary start to appear as early as 18 MONTHS

THIRD GRADE reading ability is one of the best predictors of HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION






# Developmentally Appropriate Practice



Development and learning advance when children are challenged to achieve at a level just beyond their current mastery and when they have many opportunities to reflect on and practice newly acquired skills.










# Expository or

Nonfiction focusing on factual information or processes.

Informational

### Combination

Content that has shared elements embedded within the text.

### Predictable Text

Books that use literary devices such as alliteration, rhyme, repeated sentence frames, or cumulative text with one sentence added to the next.

### Concept

Narrative


Stories with one or more characters, a

problem, and a plot

that leads to a resolution.

Books that introduce and teach a skill or concept such as alphabet, opposites, shapes, colors, object names, etc.
