Child Care Licensing System (CCL)

The Child Care Licensing (CCL) system is an online tool that allows child care providers to submit their licensing and self-declaration applications and renewals online.

In addition to application and renewal processes, all other business-related documents must now be submitted online.



The Self-Service Portal (SSP) is an online tool that allows child care providers to submit their monthly Child Care Assistance Program payment requests online.



Child Care Assistance Program (CCAP) payments are requested through the Self-Service Portal (SSP). This must be completed each month the child is in your care.
