# Classroom Assessment Scoring System® (CLASS®) Assessor- Endorsement Requirements

Updated 9-2025

A CLASS® Assessor is a professional who conducts on-site observations for early childhood programs participating in Bright & Early, North Dakota's Quality Rating and Improvement System (QRIS). The CLASS® Assessor must maintain certification and reliability in the Infant, Toddler, and/or Pre-K CLASS® observation tool.

Two endorsements are available: Primary and Provisional.

## **Early Childhood Workforce Registry Membership**

Must be a current member of the Registry

#### **Education**

<u>Provisional</u> - Obtained a <u>Career Pathway</u> placement of Category E or Higher <u>Primary</u> - Obtained a <u>Career Pathway</u> placement of Category G or Higher

### Certification

<u>Both Primary and Provisional</u> - Has a current Infant, Toddler, and/or Pre-K CLASS® Reliability Certificate from Teachstone®.

#### **Endorsement Duration**

<u>Provisional</u> - the endorsement is valid for twelve (12) months with no more than two (2) renewals.

<u>Primary</u> - endorsement is valid for three (3) years.

#### **Required Training**

<u>Both Primary and Provisional</u> - The following training must be verified on the individual's Registry Learning Record as completed <u>prior to</u> application for the primary endorsement.
