

Child Care Health Consultant- Primary Endorsement Requirements

Updated 9-2025

A Child Care Health Consultant is a professional who provides support, resources, and technical assistance to early childhood professionals—including caregivers, teachers, supervisors, directors, and administrators—achieving and maintaining health and safety standards¹.

Early Childhood Workforce Registry Membership

Must be a current member of the Registry

Education and Licensure

Must be verified on the individual's education tab in the Registry and meet one of the following requirements:

- Licensure as a Registered Nurse by the North Dakota Board of Nursing
- Licensure as a Practical Nurse by the North Dakota Board of Nursing
- Bachelor's Degree or Master's Degree in Public Health, Community Health, or Maternal and Child Health

Endorsement Duration

The primary endorsement is valid for three (3) years.

Required Training

The following training must be verified on the individual's Registry Learning Record as completed prior to application for this endorsement.
