Poster Guidelines

- Posters must be printed and mounted on standard trifold boards (36"Hx48"W).
- Display tables will be provided.
- Posters must be set up by 4:00 PM on the day of the event.
- Presenters are responsible for printing and transporting their posters.
- All abstracts will be reviewed by a peer committee to ensure quality, relevance, and clarity.
