RE: Tribal Consultation on the 1915(c) Medicaid waiver Traditional IID/DD waiver amendment application

This letter is regarding Tribal Consultation established between the North Dakota Department of Health and Human Services and the North Dakota Indian Tribes. This consultation process was established to ensure Tribal governments are included in the decision-making processes when changes in the Medicaid or Children's Health Insurance Program(s) will affect items such as cost or reductions and additions to the program.

This letter provides the opportunity for consultation on the proposed amendment to the Traditional IID/DD waiver. The Department's Developmental Disabilities (DD) Division intends to submit a 1915 (c) waiver addendum to the current Traditional IID/DD waiver dated January 1, 2021, to the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid (CMS).
