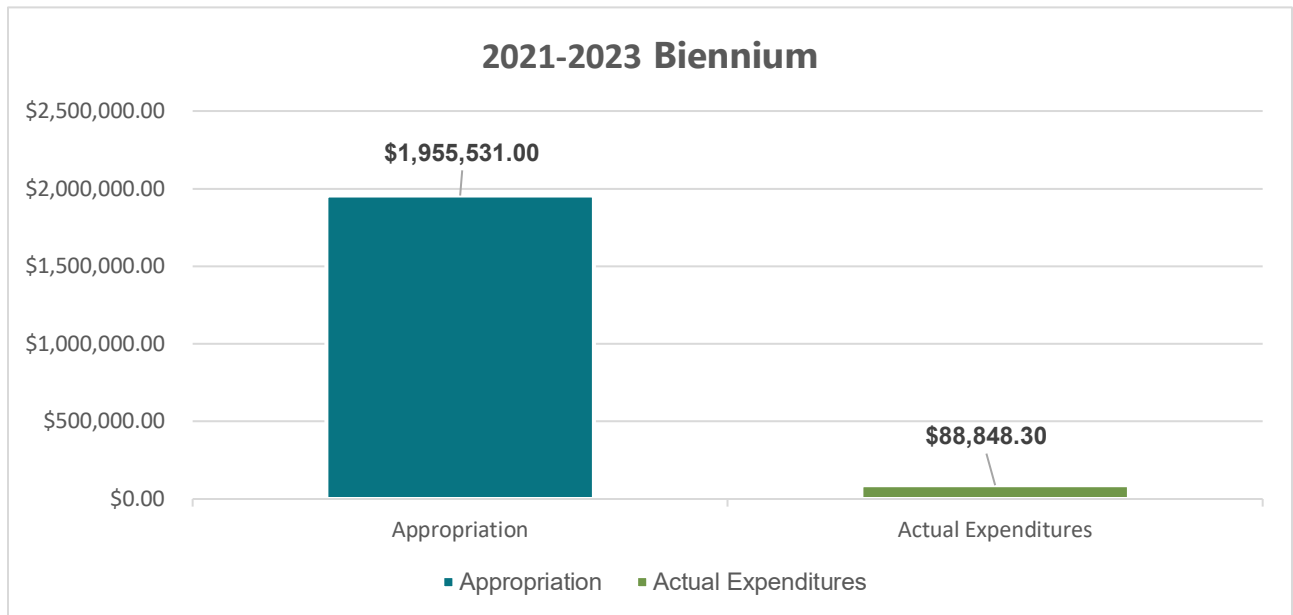
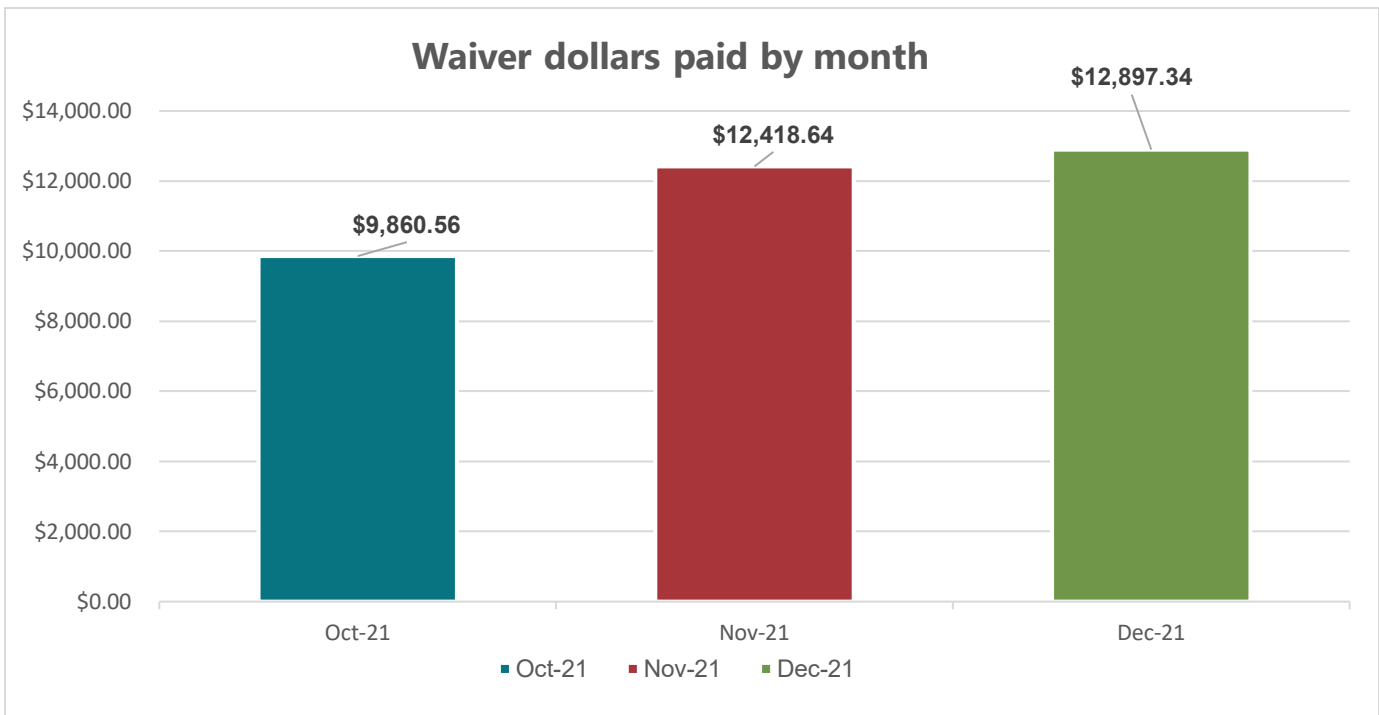
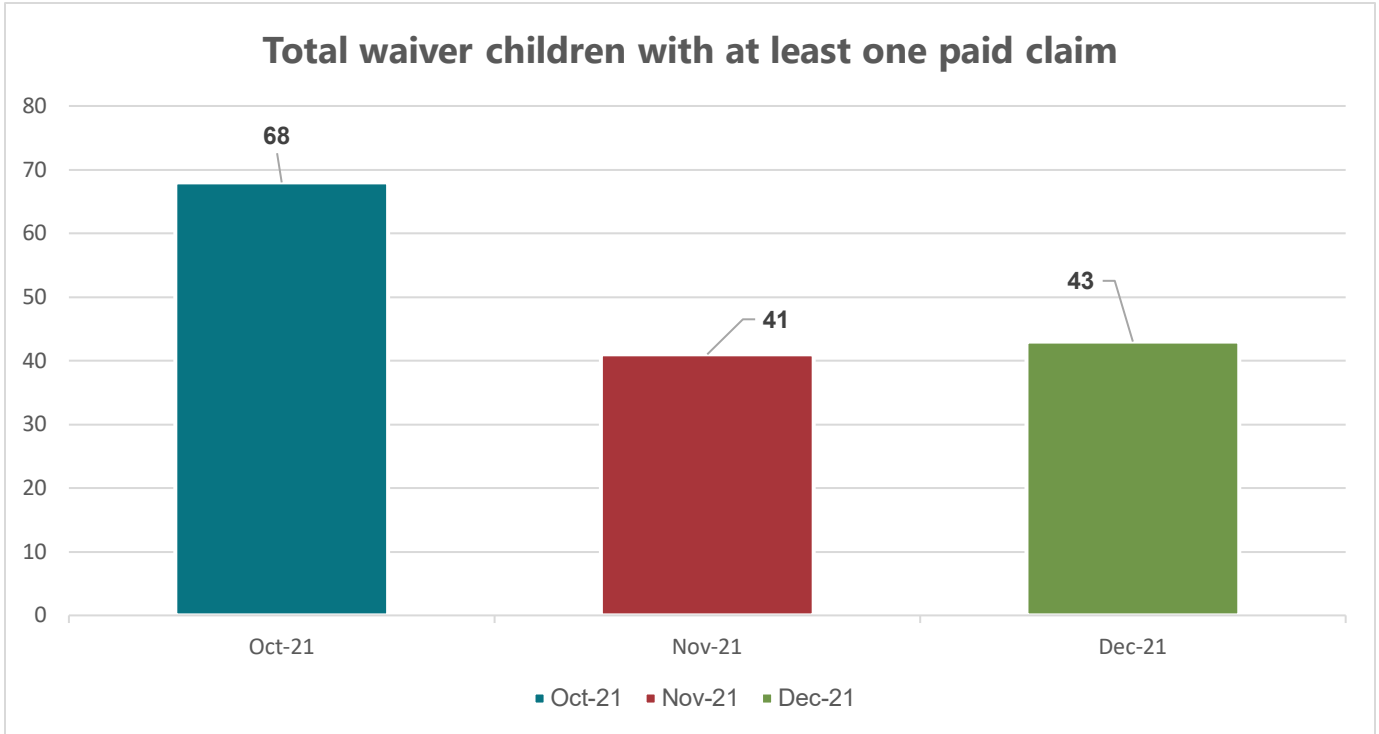


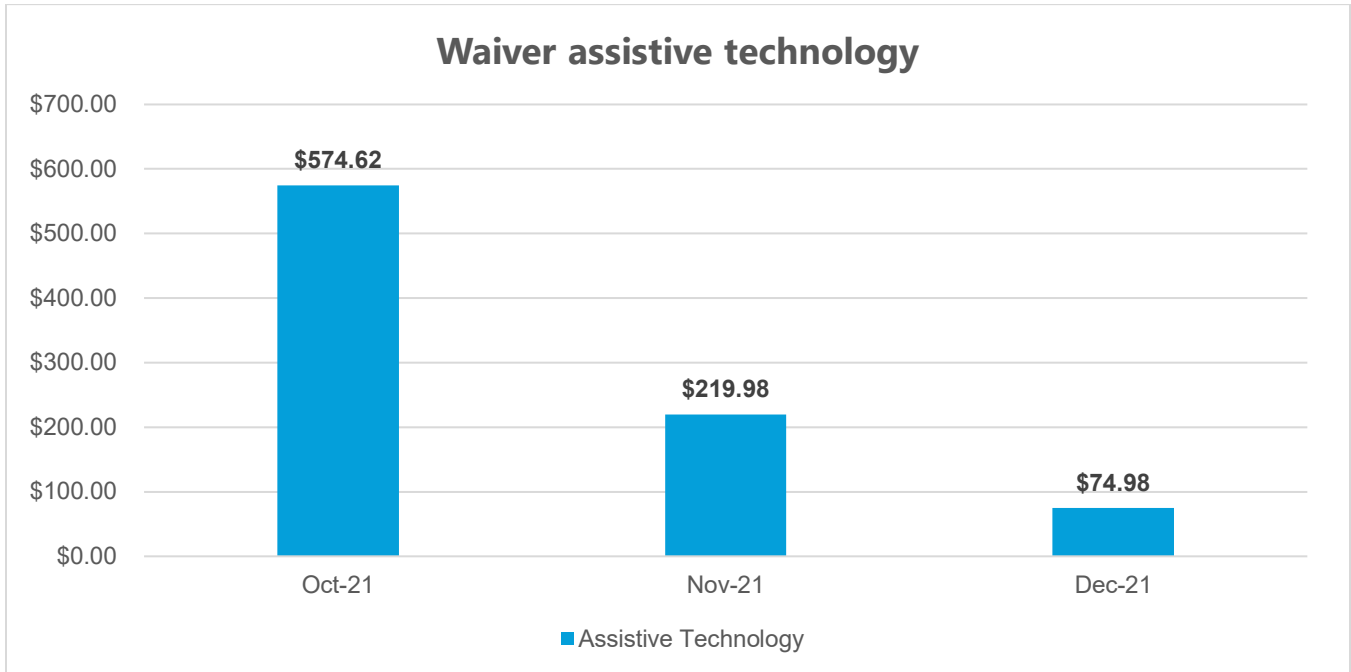
Medicaid Autism Waiver

- **All claims for service management and respite have been delayed since the implementation of Electronic Visit Verification starting January 1, 2021.**

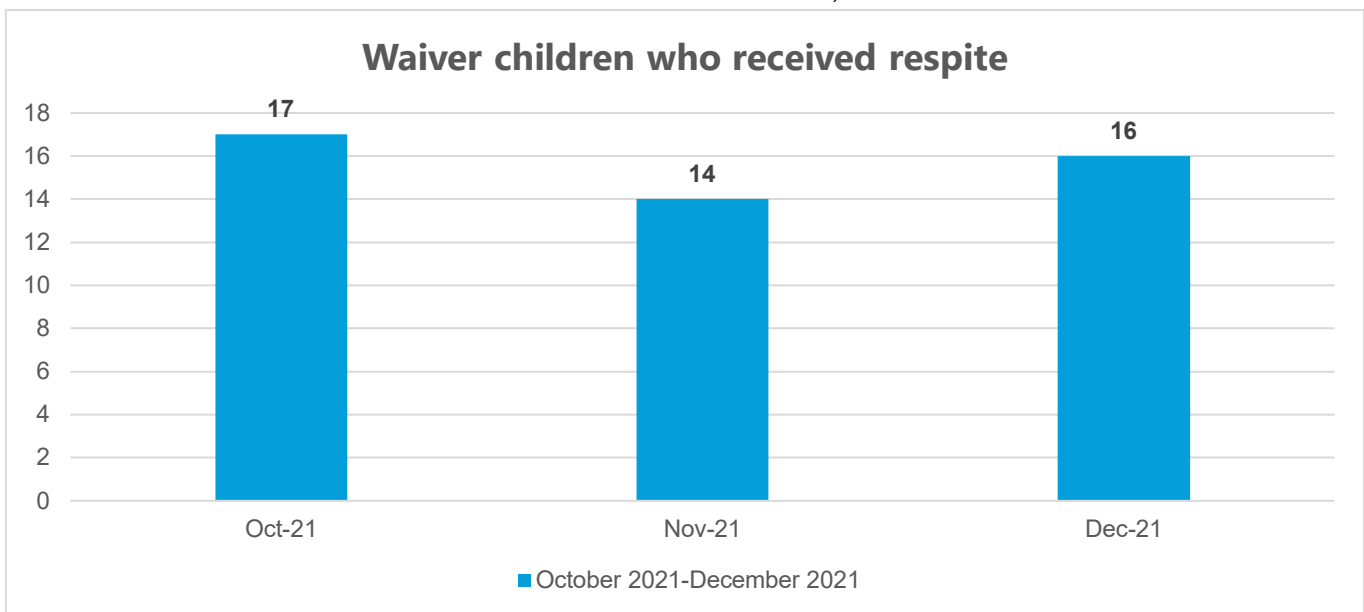
Enrollment is 150 children: 67 urban, 18 semi-rural, and 10 rural. 95 active, 33 working on Medicaid, 17 working on returning Vineland booklet, and 5 new vinelands sent out (original family offered slot either are on DD waiver or have moved out of state). There are 58 children on the waitlist.



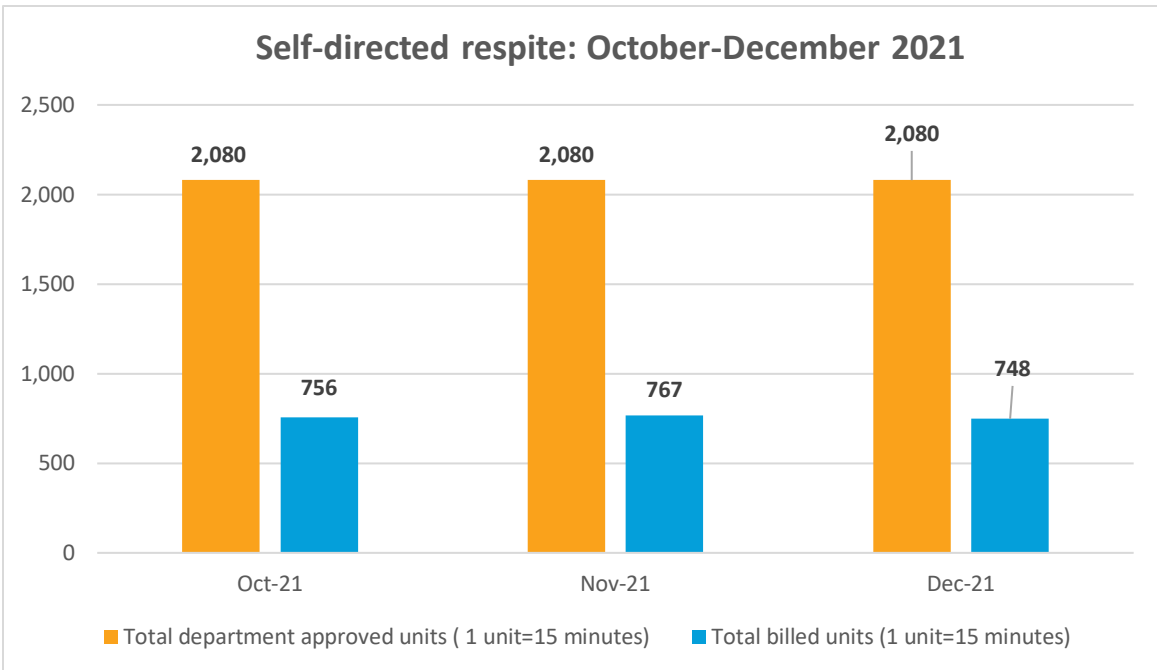
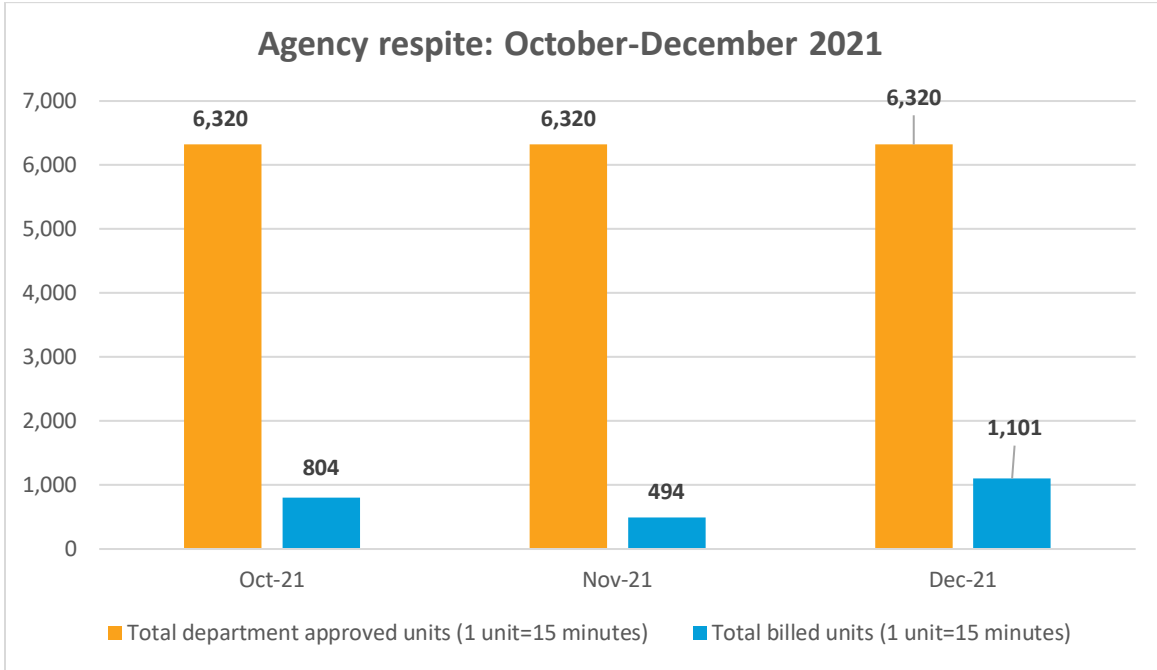


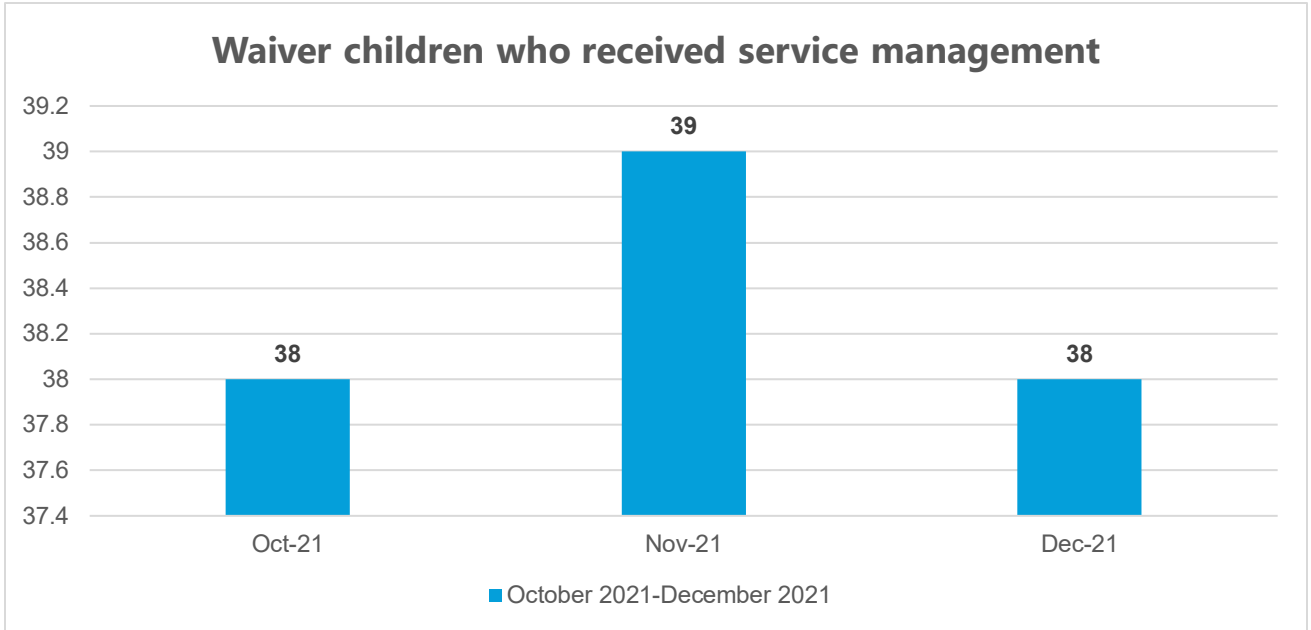

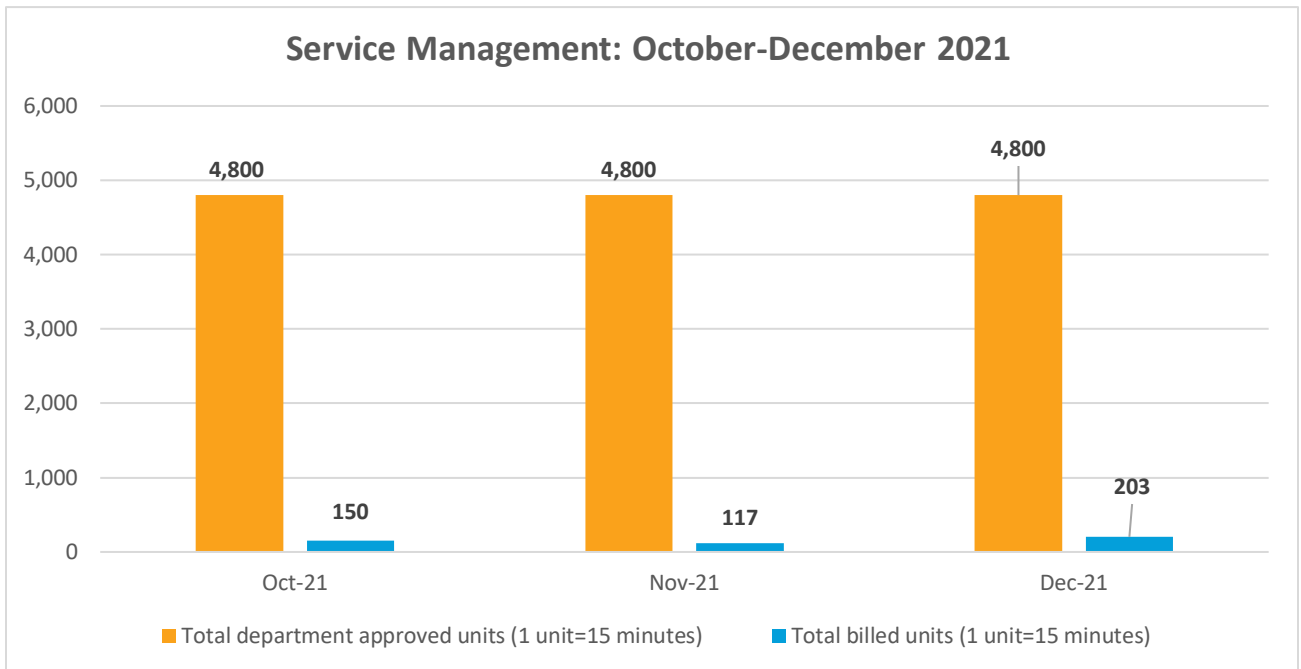


- October 2021: 17 children; 13 urban, 3 semi-rural, and 1 rural

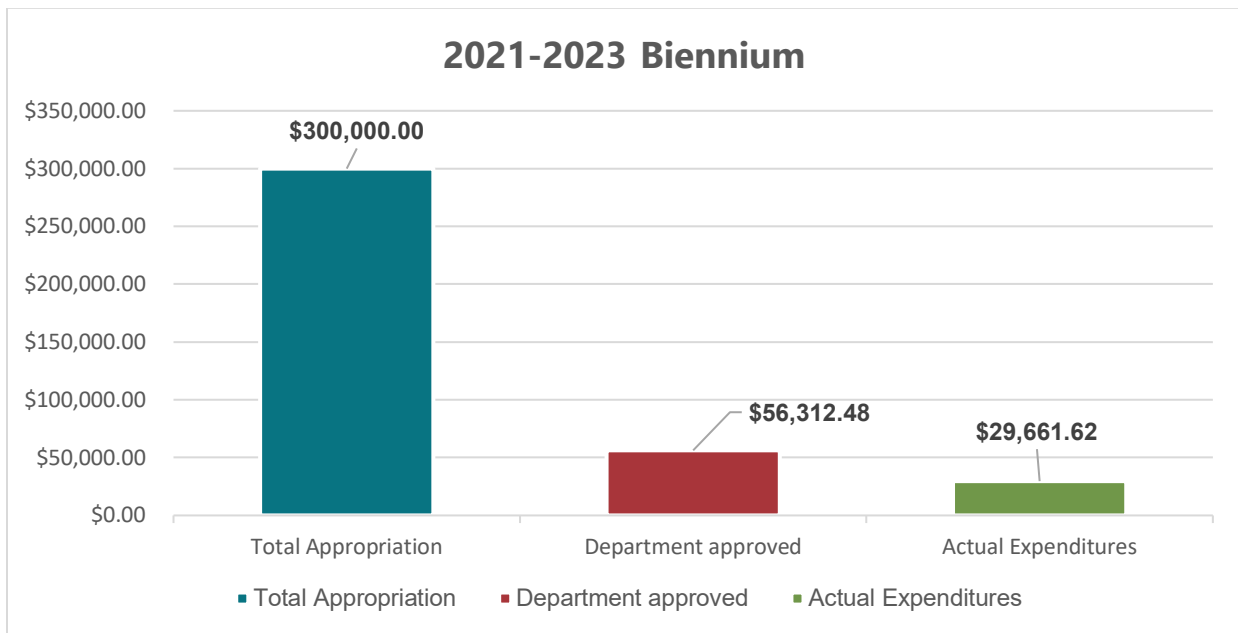

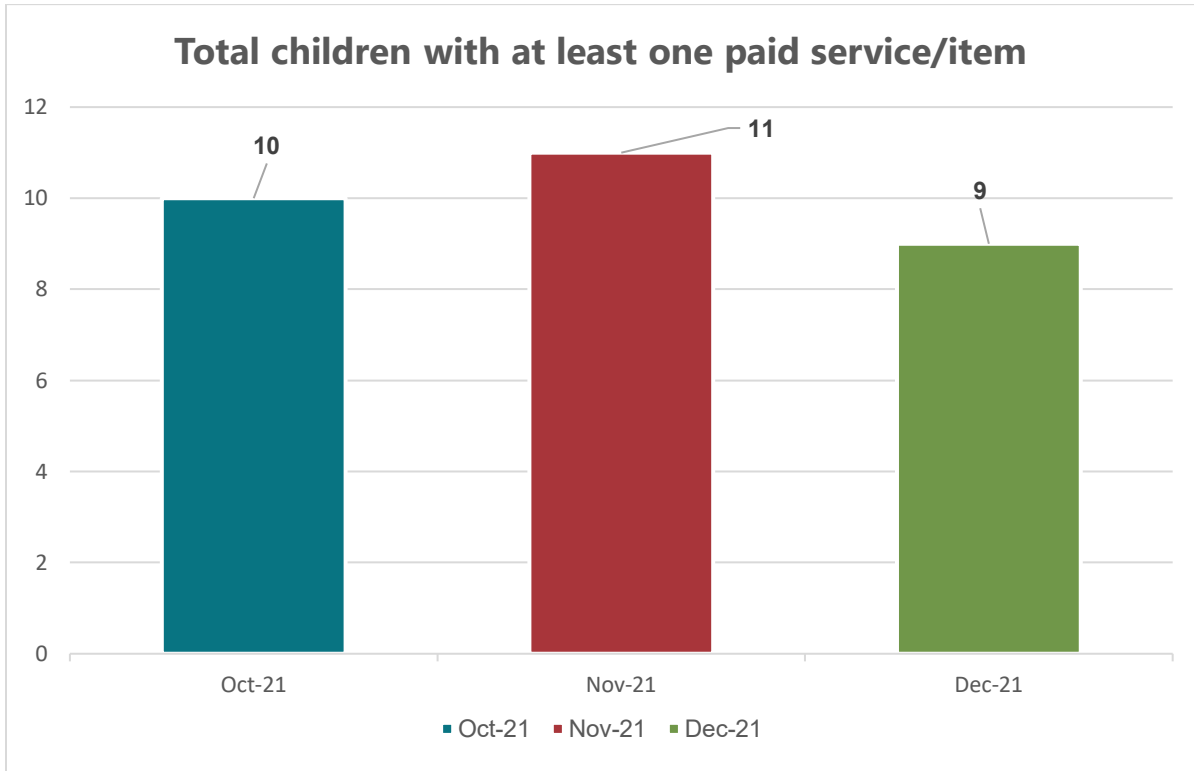

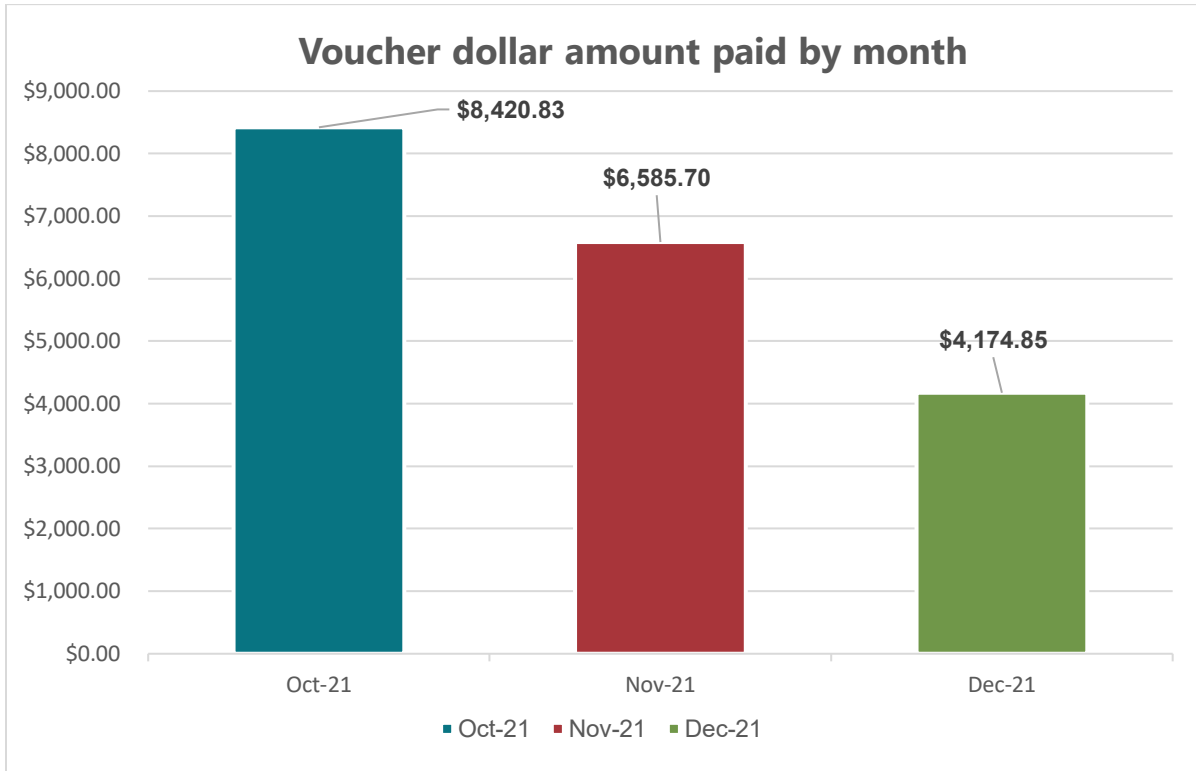
Total enrollment so far for the 2021-2022 program year is 37 children: 19 urban, 8 semi-rural, and 10 rural.

- October 2021-December 2021 enrollment: 8 children added to voucher. 5 urban, 1 semi-rural, and 2 rural

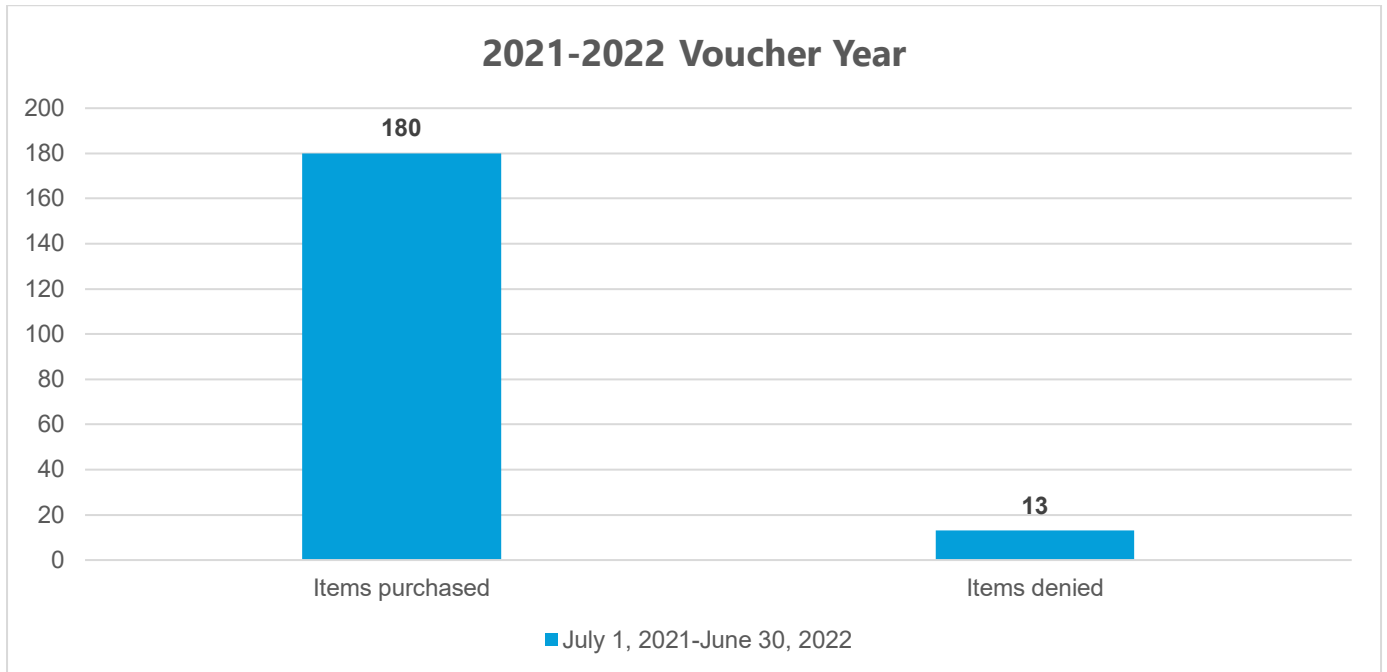




- October 2021 expenditures: 10 children; 3 urban, 3 semi-rural, and 4 rural

Voucher Items Purchased/Denied and Respite by year:



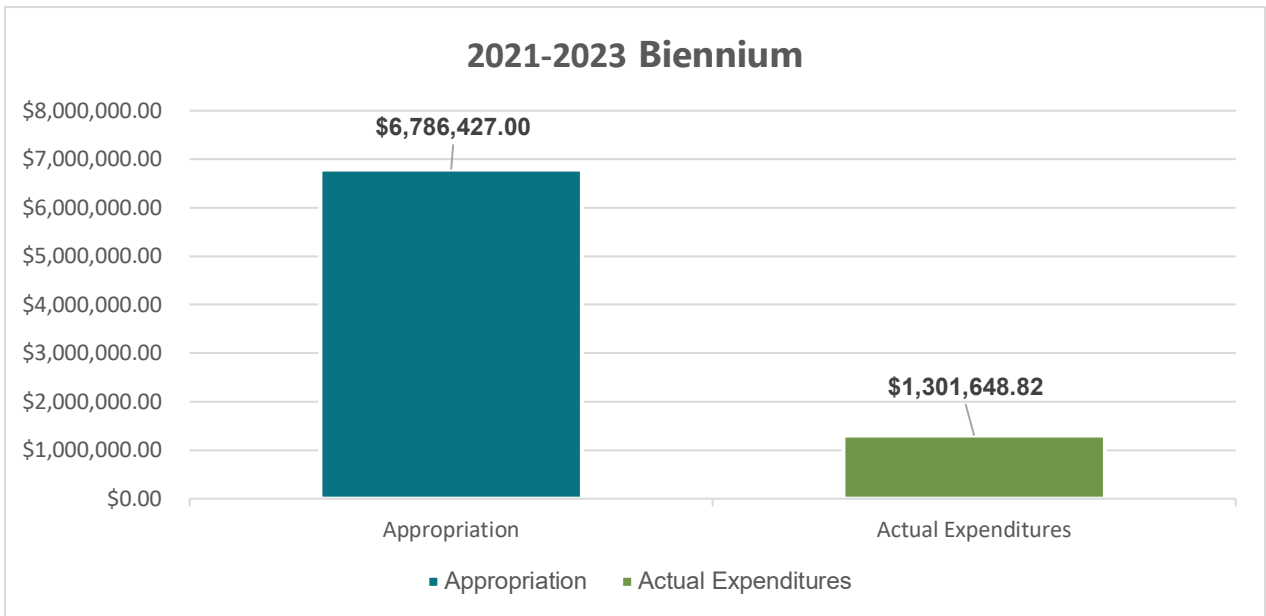
Summary:

- 12 items denied

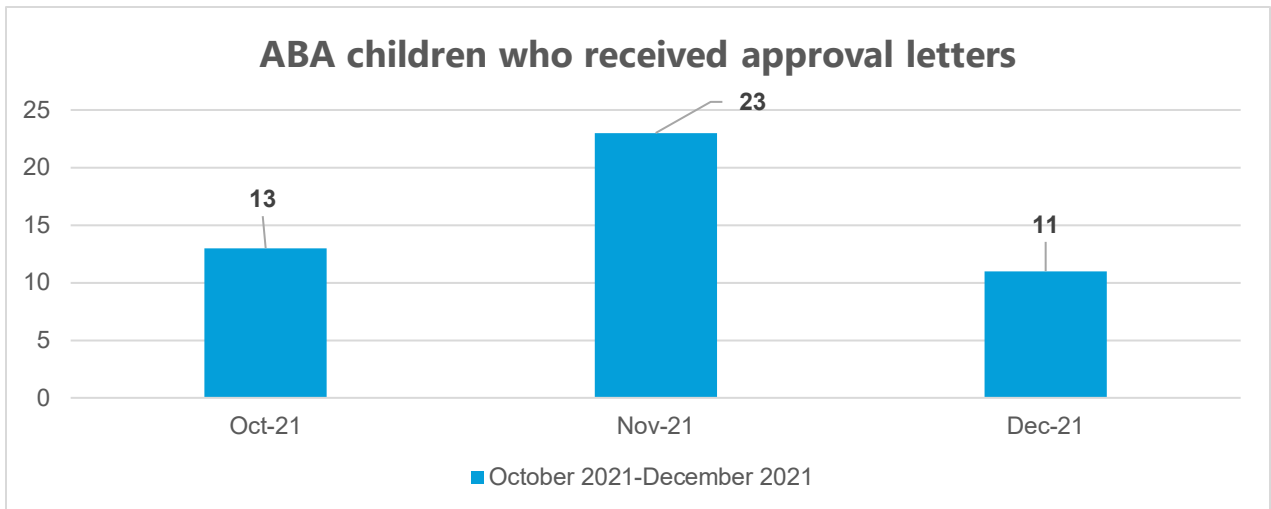
Reasons for denial:

- Duplication to item(s) already purchased
- Item not listed in letter of recommendation
- Items on purchase request are not tied to the deficits caused by the child’s autism diagnosis
- Duplicate item(s)/service(s) that address identical deficit goals
- Parental responsibility
- Item is considered a restriction
